

MOUNT RILEY MERLOT MALBEC 2012

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

The grapes that went into this wine were grown at low yields in premium Mount Riley Marlborough vineyards located in the central Wairau Valley. A fruit driven style of bordeaux red with plenty of juicy dark and red fruits and a soft tannin structure. The wine was matured in a mixture of French and American oak barriques (10% new) for ten months before blending.

TASTING NOTES:

Colour Magenta Purple.

Bouquet Bright, red fruits and Black

Doris Plum, complemented by light spice, chocolate and mocha

aromas.

Palate A medium bodied wine with ripe

red and brambly darker fruit flavours and soft, supple tannins.

Drink A delicious warming winter

wine, excellent matched with red meat and game. Drinking well

now or cellar until 2017.
