



## MOUNT RILEY RIESLING 2013

### WINEMAKERS NOTES:

Our 2013 Riesling is made from grapes grown on Mount Riley's Litchfield and Anderson Vineyards in Marlborough's Wairau Valley. Marlborough's (and New Zealand's) summer over the 2012/2013 growing season will be remembered as one "out of the box". Warm, settled and dry conditions from early December right through until mid April allowed fantastic ripening and flavour development with virtually no disease pressure.

Grapes were harvested in pristine condition then crushed and destemmed. Fermentation was carried out at cool temperatures in stainless steel to achieve absolute purity of fruit.

### TASTING NOTES:

<i>Colour</i>	Light straw. Brilliant.
<i>Bouquet</i>	A perfumed wine with orange blossom, spice, lime and nectarine characters.
<i>Palate</i>	Off dry with crisp acidity to balance slight sweetness. Intensely flavoursome with a long finish.
<i>Drink</i>	Drinking well now, this wine will continue to improve and develop until 2016. Great as an aperitif or match with seafood, light meats & spicy foods.
